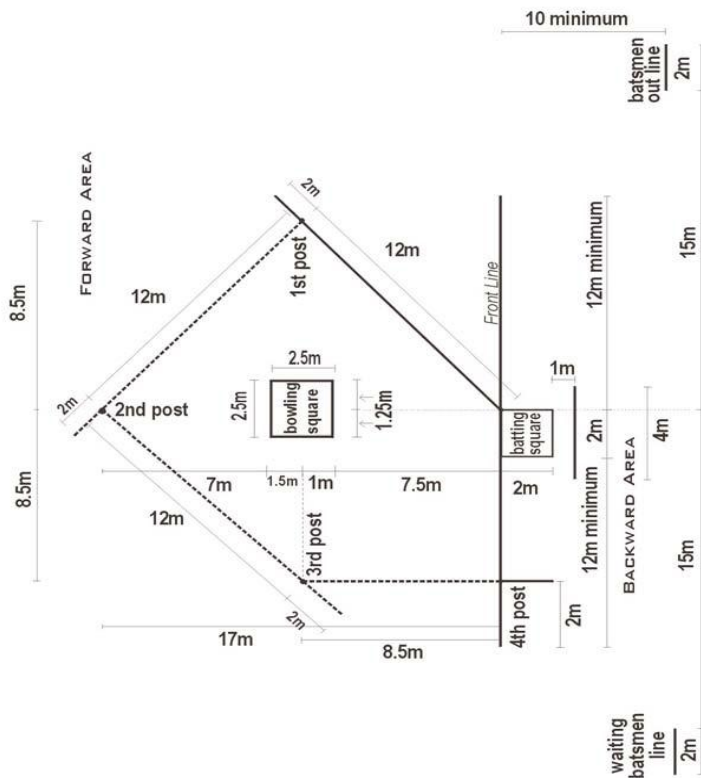




Rounders



Pitch/Marking Guidelines

Batting Area

12m square.

Running Track

A solid line extending from the front right hand corner of the batting square to the first post measuring 12m long will be marked. The same line will be extended past the first post by 2m. The distance from the batting square to the second post and the first post to the third post is 17m. The fourth post measures in a straight line from the third post 8.5m and extends 2m over the front line of the batting square. The lines from the first post to the second post and the second post to the third post will also be extended by 2m respectively.

Bowling Square

2.5m square.

Batting Square

2m square. The front line of the batting square extends 12m minimum in either direction. The area in front of this line toward the bowling square is called the forward area and the area behind it is called the backward area.

The front line is parallel with and 7.5m away from the front line of the bowling square.

Batsman Outline and Waiting Line

10m minimum behind the front line of the batting square and 15m on both sides of the front right hand corner of the batting square, they are then marked 2m long from that point.

Posts

1.2m above the ground. They shall be supported in a base and not fixed into the ground.

Line Width

2.5cm minimum, 5cm maximum.

Colour

White lines are suggested but not specified.
